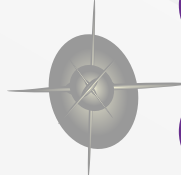

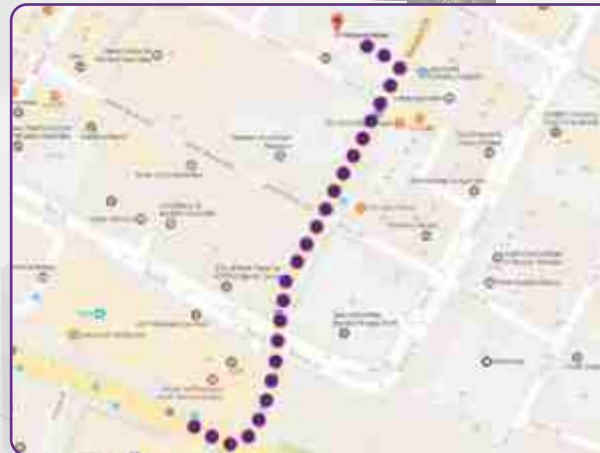

SIT30816 - Certificate III in Commercial Cookery

CRICOS Code: 092047A

Course Overview

This qualification trains a person to work as a cook in Australia. Certificate III in Commercial Cookery is a basic cooking course. Work-based training is an essential component of this course which helps students with the necessary on-the-job experience in a commercial kitchen.
